Dr. Gerald James Sciaraffa, 47, health officer and president of the health department of Elgin since 1955, died yesterday in St. Joseph's hospital, Elgin. He was chairman of the obstetrics and gynecology department of the hospital in 1956-57 and president of the hospital staff the preceding year.

Dr. Sciaraffa, who lived at 485 Hubbard st., Elgin, had practiced medicine in Elgin since 1942. He attended Loyola university and received his medical degrees from the Chicago Medical school. Dr. Sciaraffa was president of the American Academy of General Practice for several years.
